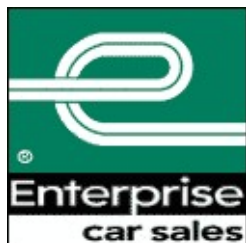

Your refund can be direct deposited to your account within 8–14 days when we e-file your return.
